Adding across the ten

Subtracting across the ten

Split the second number so you land on ten first, then finish the jump.

$$13 - 5 = \square$$

$$\begin{aligned} 5 &= \square + \square \\ 13 - \square &= 10 \\ 10 - \square &= \square \end{aligned}$$

$$15 - 7 = \square$$

$$\begin{aligned} 7 &= \square + \square \\ 15 - \square &= 10 \\ 10 - \square &= \square \end{aligned}$$

$$12 - 6 = \square$$

$$\begin{aligned} 6 &= \square + \square \\ 12 - \square &= 10 \\ 10 - \square &= \square \end{aligned}$$

$$16 - 8 = \square$$
